2. **Naloxone:** Bay li si w genyen l. Si premye dòz la fè moun nan reviv, ba li yon dezyèm dòz.
3. **Respirasyon Atifisyèl:** mete tèt la wo, leve manton an, epi peze nen an. Bay 1 souf chak 5 segonn.
4. **Pozisyon Rekovremant:** si w dwe kite moun nan poukont li, mete li bò gòch li.

**Emergency Treatment of an  
Opioid Overdose**

1. **Call 9-1-1:** Immediately. The Good Samaritan Law protects you from prosecution. Don't run; call 9-1-1!
2. **Naloxone:** Give if you have it. If first dose does not revive the person, administer a second dose.
3. **Rescue Breathing:** Tilt the head, lift the chin, and pinch the nose. Give 1 breath every 5 seconds.
4. **Recovery Position:** If you must leave the person alone, place them on his or her left side.
